CalEITC4Me Adds Mandarin Resources and Tools

Mike Eng To Discuss How the Earned Income Tax Credit Helps Working Families Build Economic Security

San Gabriel, CA – In an effort to remove barriers to claiming the Earned Income Tax Credit, CalEITC4Me is distributing new Mandarin language information and resources Thursday at the Asian Youth Center Food Bank and ACE After School Program. Nearly \$50 million in state EITC is available to eligible low-income working families in Los Angeles County and hundreds of millions more from the federal EITC are left on the table each year by LA County residents.

“Barriers including language and the cost of filing stand between many hard working families and the extra income they’ve earned through EITC. This year we’ve added Mandarin language resources and information to CalEITC4Me.org to help eligible families find out how much they can receive and where they can get their taxes prepared for free in their neighborhoods,” said **Joseph N. Sanberg, CalEITC4Me Chair**. “By bringing Mandarin resources directly to communities, we are delivering a message that we are here to help hard working Californians build economic security.”

What: Community organizations will be distributing Mandarin CalEITC materials to over 200 families during a food bank distribution and after school program. Mandarin speaking families in the San Gabriel Valley make up one of the largest concentration in the State of California.
